

Finding out who your MSPs are

The Scottish Parliament website has details of the current MSPs. This will get updated after the election

Go to the constituency map. This shows the Regional constituencies.

- Within this, you will get the local constituencies
- You also get the Regional MSPs, who are also there for everyone living in that region.

You can then get the email and full contact details for each MSP

The website also shows how each MSP has voted, questions they are raised and other activity. You can also see what committees and cross-party groups they are on.

Most have their own external website, which is usually managed by the political party they belong to.

- You will get details of surgeries that they hold
- There may also be a way to contact a local office
- You can see what local issues they have been taking up – the sorts of things that do not feature in the Parliament, such as writing to the local Council on behalf of constituents.
