



The purpose of the Proposals for a Heat in Buildings Bill: Consultation is to make people aware of the Scottish Government's proposal to make new laws around the heating systems that can be used in homes and places of work, and to invite your views on those proposals.

The consultation describes the proposals for how home owners and landlords can meet this standard – either through installing a number of simple insulation and draught-proofing measures, where those are possible, or by meeting a certain level of heat demand. The Government will take all views received into account and adapt their proposals in a way that reflects those.
